- Disputation and arguing
- Excessively embellished speech
- Lewd, insulting or crude speech
- Invoking curses on others
- Singing immoral poetry
- Excessive joking
- Sarcasm and ridicule
- Revealing secrets
- False promises
- Lying and false oaths
- Backbiting and slander
- Instigating disputes
- Being two-faced
- Praising undeserving people
- Speaking without proper knowledge
- Ordinary people speaking on specialist matters

May Allah spare us from these both during and after Ramadan.
